Your submission will be reviewed by qualified Autism Society San Diego board members. If approved, your submission will then be posted on the local web site under “News & Events”/ “Research Studies” for a period of 3 months. Investigators can contact the Autism Society office after the 3-month period to request additional 3-month extensions for posting of their study if IRB approval is still in effect.
